

Procedural Sedation Checklist

Signed consent in chart
Free flowing IV with IV fluids running
Bag valve attached to oxygen, with mask connected
Suction set-up and tested, with Yankaeur attached, in packaging
Intubation Kit at bedside

- o ET tube with stylet and 1cc syringe attached and balloon tested
- Appropriate blade attached to handle and light tested
- Secondary intubation method identified and available

Medication at bedside

- Sedation medications, with appropriate doses confirmed verbally with RN
- Narcan available
- Glycopyrollate available

Endtidal CO2 setup and working
Non-rebreather mask on patient
Cardiac monitor on patient
Evaluate airway using LEMON mnemonic
Calculate ASA score

Classification	Description
Class I	Normal, healthy patient
Class II	Patient with mild systemic disease—a mild to moderate systemic disorder related to the condition to be treated or to some other, unrelated process
Class III	Patient with severe systemic disease that limits activity but is not incapacitating
Class IV	Patient with incapacitating systemic disease that is life threatening
Class V	Moribund patient not expected to survive 24 hr without an operation

Questions before initiating sedation

Time and contents of last meal
Confirm weight
Prior reactions to anesthesia or medications
Drug Allergies
History of Obstructive Sleep Apnea
History of intubations

Proceed with sedation, starting with introduction of team members & timeout.
